*Bubbles Academy, Chicago — Arts Integrated Early Childhood Development Educator

I teach a variety of arts-integrated parent/child classes and CPS enrichment for children age 0-4 to promote healthy sensory, motor and emotional development. These classes are meant to strengthen the bond between a child and their primary caregiver, while teaching the adults how to gently facilitate their child's development, curiosity, ingenuity and autonomy.

*Aloft Circus Arts, Chicago — Aerial & Circus Arts Instructor, Expressive Arts Facilitator

I lead trapeze classes for adults, with an emphasis on body awareness, mobility and anatomy. I scaffold each class to fit the people in it after checking in on their emotional and physical well-being. I also teach circus arts to children ages 4-6 and 7-12, incorporating vestibular and proprioceptive exercises to help their gross motor development and body awareness, as well as employing Social Emotional Learning techniques to build positive relationships.

In addition, Aloft has hired me as an Expressive Arts facilitator for their Professional Training Program students. I have facilitated visual art, movement and writing with them addressing the "Inner Critic" and how it impedes the creative process in their act creation.

*Misericordia Heart of Mercy, Chicago — Sing Along Host & Performer, volunteer

Resident Events staff selected me to host the sing along nights for residents. I prepare songs they request and repeat what they love, accompany myself on the ukulele and dance with the residents. I've been brought back to perform on other event nights like Disco Show and Circus Night.

Get a Grip Trapeze (Formerly TSNY), Chicago — Aerial Instructor

I led open level trapeze classes for adults, emphasising body awareness, mobility and anatomy. Since the classes are open level and drop-in based, I would have a variety of ages, skill and strength levels join my classes, so I engaged in an adaptive style of teaching, bringing a buffet of options to the class so each participant could choose what worked best for them.

PlayMakers Laboratory, Chicago — *Company Member*

I have been a part of the ensemble that goes to CPS schools to teach narrative writing skills and encourage students to tell their original stories as a mode of personal expression. Towards the end of the school year, PML members like myself would gather these stories and bring them to life in a sketch-like format to perform for each school.

The Music Playhouse of Chicago, Chicago — Music Teacher

I taught music to children ages 0-6 and their caregivers to foster independent music accuracy. Their earning is engaged through props, instruments and movement, as well as showing caregivers how to model music making for their child at home. I also conducted rounds and tonal/rhythmic pattern repetition to help everyone develop their pitch and rhythmic skills.

The Stage School, Park Ridge, IL — *Drama Instructor*

I taught drama basics weekly to children ages 6-14 through improv and collaborative games, script readings and scene creation. Throughout the session, we worked with specific scenes from classic shows, and I directed them for a final revue style production.

Wilmette Parks and Rec, Wilmette, IL — Circus Program Director

I collaborated with the Parks and Rec district to develop a youth circus program for the summer. I developed and taught workshops, and created a summer camp curriculum for children ages 7-14. There was no aerial rigging capability in the building, so these were all general circus skills such as juggling, tumbling, hula hoops & clown.
